



Vlad Glăveanu, PhD, is Associate Professor and Head of the Department of Psychology and Counselling at Webster University Geneva, Associate Professor II at Bergen University, Norway, and Director of the [Webster Center for Creativity and Innovation \(WCCI\)](#). His work focuses on creativity, imagination, culture, collaboration, and societal challenges. He edited the *Palgrave Handbook of Creativity and Culture* (2016) and the *Oxford Creativity Reader* (2019), and co-edited the *Cambridge Handbook of Creativity Across Domains* (2017) and the *Oxford Handbook of Imagination and Culture* (2017). He co-edits the book series *Palgrave Studies in Creativity and Culture* and is the editor of the *Encyclopedia of the Possible*, a major reference work with Palgrave Macmillan that will be completed in 2021. Vlad is editor of *Europe's Journal of Psychology* (EJOP), an open-access peer-reviewed journal published by PsychOpen (Germany). He received in 2018 the Berlyne Award from the American Psychological Association for outstanding early career contributions to the field of aesthetics, creativity, and the arts.
