





- A training kit will be developed, aimed at the whole spectrum of volunteers and
 professionals involved in the initial reception of newly arrived migrants in European
 countries, focusing on the understanding and analysis of cultural differences during this
 transitional phase. The kit will be designed for all the people working with migrants, based
 on an in-depth study of their respective needs. It will make use of recent academic research
 on interculturality to go beyond the limits of traditional tools for raising awareness of
 cultural differences.
- The conceptual dimension of the project seeks to provide a practical application of critical approaches, based on varied and innovative methodologies, to create a user-friendly and visually attractive final product.
- Once developed, the training kit will be disseminated free of charge to be used in various contexts (state-sponsored institutions, NGOs, educational/academic communities, private businesses) and adapted to specific local realities.

SIETAR Switzerland plans to deliver train-the-trainer programs for kit users and facilitators.
